The Event The event shall be a Ride Day for children from various charities and their families promoted and organised by the Western Australian Off-Road Racing Association (WAORRA). Drivers will be available to provide charity rides to the children, in a controlled and safe manner.

The event will be held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the National Competition Rules (NCR) of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS), the Khanacross Regulations, the CAMS Guidelines for Passengers in Vehicles, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations authorised by CAMS.

The event will be non-competitive.

Eligibility

Drivers must be members of WAORRA, with current Club Membership Cards and CAMS Licences required to be produced at documentation.

Scrutiny

Vehicles must pass scrutiny and comply with 'General Requirements for Cars and Drivers' as per CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. A fire extinguisher complying with Schedule H of the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport must be fitted for vehicles. Cars must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions. Vehicles will not be sorted into classes for the event.

Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual.

Safety

All drivers and passengers whilst participating, must wear a helmet and apparel complying with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, and be fully strapped in with racing harness complying with the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. Vehicles' speed will be greatly reduced from normal competition speed in order to comply with the Guidelines for Passengers in Vehicles.

Apparel

Neck to wrist to ankle, non-synthetic clothing must be worn; 100% cotton or wool garments (including socks) are acceptable. Suitable and appropriate footwear (e.g. with leather upper) must be worn, shoes made of synthetic material, thongs, roman sandals and high heels do not comply.

Rights of Driver

Any party in the vehicle has the right to request the cessation of all activities which are outside the comfort level of either party. The vehicle must be slowed when safe to do so and then returned to the pits. This action must also be taken if a mechanical fault is identified or suspected.

Drivers are required to report any driver or vehicle he feels to be dangerous or inappropriate to the event organisers or scrutineer. At their discretion a vehicle and/or driver can be prevented from participating further in the event.

All Drivers must be present at the Drivers Briefing if they wish to participate in the event.

All Charity Families must be present at the Passenger Briefing if they wish to participate in the event.

Postponement

The organiser reserves the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the event in accordance with NCR 59.

Anti Doping Policy

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

Insurance

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au.

Drivers and all officials must sign the Entry Form or Official Sign-On/Indemnity Form as appropriate.

Additional Info

Results, awards and timing will not occur at this event due to the non-competitive nature of the event. The Clerk of the Course shall be the judge of Fact for all aspects of the event.
