The Event The event shall be a WAORRA Kids Ride Day promoted and organised by the Western Australian Off Road Racing Association (WAORRA) Inc. Drivers will be available to provide rides in competitive off-road vehicles for the children and their families, in a controlled and safe manner.

The event will be held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the National Competition Rules (NCR) of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS), the Khanacross Regulations, the CAMS Guidelines for Passengers in Vehicles, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations authorised by CAMS.

This event will be conducted under and in accordance with the CAMS Risk Management and Occupational Health and Safety Policies. These policies and the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport can be found at www.cams.com.au.

This event will be a Non-Competitive Ride Day for Children.

Eligibility

Drivers must be members of WAORRA, with current Club Membership Cards and CAMS Licences required (minimum L2NS or Higher) to be produced at Documentation.

Scrutiny

Vehicles must pass Scrutiny and comply with "General Requirements for Cars and Drivers" as per CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. A Fire Extinguisher complying with Schedule H of the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport must be fitted for Vehicles. Cars must be adequately muffled to comply with Noise Restrictions. Vehicles will not be sorted into Classes for the Event.

Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual.

Safety

All Drivers and Passengers whilst participating, must wear a Helmet and Apparel complying with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, and be fully strapped in with Racing Harness complying with the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. Vehicles Speed will be greatly reduced from normal competition Speed in order to comply with the Guidelines for Passengers in Vehicles.

Passengers

This Event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the CAMS MSPRA Policy.

- (a) A briefing must be attended by each Driver and Passenger (and guardians of each Passenger if Passenger is under 18 years of age) conducted by the Clerk of the Course prior to the MSPRA commencing.
- (b) Passengers MUST:
 - i. wear the same protective gear as a Driver
 - ii. Be fitted and restrained as required for each Automobile with consideration for their physical attributes
 - iii. Complete a Passenger Ride Entry Form and disclaimer
 - iv. Drivers must fill out a Passenger Ride Entry Form to ride as a passenger.
 - v. Be at least 12 years of age
- (c) Vehicles and Apparel used must pass Scrutiny.
- (d) Vehicles shall only carry one Passenger at a time, unless otherwise approved by CAMS.

Apparel

Neck to Wrist to ankle, non-synthetic clothing must be worn; 100% cotton or wool garments (including socks) are acceptable. Suitable and appropriate Footwear (e.g. with leather upper) must be worn, shoes made of synthetic material, thongs, roman sandals and high heels DO NOT Comply.

Rights of Driver

Any Passenger in the Vehicle has the right to request the cessation of all Activities which are outside the comfort level of either Passenger. The Vehicle must be slowed when safe to do so and then returned to the Pits. This action must also be taken if a Mechanical Fault is identified or suspected.

Drivers are required to report any Driver or Vehicle he feels to be Dangerous or Inappropriate to the Event Organisers or Scrutineer. At their discretion a Vehicle and/or Driver can be prevented from participating further in the Event.

Entries Close 10/03/2018

All Drivers must be present at the Drivers Briefing if they wish to participate in the Event.

All Camp Quality Families must be present at the Briefing if they wish to participate in the Event.

Postponement

The Organiser Reserves the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the Event in Accordance with NCR 59.

Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual.

Anti Doping Policy

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

Insurance

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au.

Drivers and all officials must sign the entry form or official's sign-on/Indemnity form as appropriate.

Additional Info

Results, Awards and Timing will not occur at this Event due to the Non-Competitive nature of the Event. The Clerk of the Course shall be the Judge of Fact for all aspects of the Event.
